The Flags

Flags are from a variety of countries in addition to the Christian flag. The international flags represent some of the countries of origin of graduates, alumni, and current students. The Mace

Representing the authority bestowed upon the president by the Board of Trustees, the mace features a bronze of the college seal atop a four-foot sculpted piece of walnut. The mace is carried by Thomas Duden, Adjunct Instructor in Criminal Justice and signifies the official opening and closing of the ceremony.

Doane University Banners

The Doane University banner bears the college seal, created by Thomas Doane, Esq., and David Brainerd Perry, the first president of the college. The woman (science) trims the lamp of knowledge to light the book (Bible).

The star and cross are Christian symbols indicating Doane's Congregational heritage. Science faces west to signify westward movement of learning. The triangle denotes strength through three aspects of life: spiritual, physical, and intellectual.



STEVE JOEL, Ph.D. '76 became superintendent of Lincoln Public Schools in 2010. Previously, he served for ten years as superintendent in Grand Island, Nebraska, and eight years in Beatrice, Nebraska. A native of Long Island, New York, he has degrees from Doane College, the University of Nebraska-Lincoln, and Kansas State University.

Joel has been honored with a wide variety of awards and distinctions including: Nebraska Superintendent of the Year and Leadership Excellence by the Educational Resource Development Institute. He is active in many community clubs and coalitions, and serves on a number of boards including the Lincoln Chamber of Commerce, Foundation for Lincoln Public Schools, Lincoln Community Foundation, The Career Academy, and President of the United Way of Lincoln and Lancaster County Board.

Joel's leadership has focused on comprehensive solutions to significant school and community issues. The immigration raid in Grand Island led to the formation of a community coalition to begin the arduous process of rebuilding community unity, and the tragic fire that resulted in a complete loss of the Lincoln Public Schools District Office allowed for the construction of a new facility. More recently, Lincoln has grown rapidly to include over 42,000 students and 8,000 staff members. With Joel's leadership, Lincoln Public Schools has adopted a comprehensive instructional technology plan and developed The Career Academy leading Nebraska into the next phase of K12 education.

Joel has also served as a consultant to school districts and businesses across the country in areas of strategic planning, team building and superintendent searches.
