2. Complete a minimum of 54 credits total: ART 204, 205, 211, 232, 260, 307, 326, 343, GDC 258 and a minimum of 6 elective credits in art.
3. Take ART 260 - Introduction to Professional Practices: **Prerequisites ART 107, 110, 207, 235, 204 and 205**
4. All requirements listed under the catalog section Secondary Education.
