1. A student must earn 12 to 17 credits in Spanish in a semester or summer abroad program, with the approval of the department. The student has the option of earning up to 24 credits for a full year abroad.
2. Complete all requirements listed under the catalog section Secondary Education.
3. Complete one additional teaching major or subject endorsement.
